

## **REPORT ON INTERDEPARTMENTAL SEMINAR**

Organized by: **RESEARCH COMMITTEE**, Sao Chang College

The Research Committee conducted its 7<sup>th</sup> Interdepartmental Seminar on 30<sup>th</sup> August 2024. Held in College Conference Hall, the seminar was chaired by Mr. Lemkhaba, Assistant Professor in Education.

**Title of the program:** Listen Learn and Grow Together **Date:** 30<sup>th</sup> August 2024

### **Objective:**

To present, learn and discuss on varied specialization, recent trends and developments, research papers, promote research oriented academic interest among the faculties.

### **Description:**

The rapporteur for seminar was Ms. Tongpangkola Chang, Asst Professor Dept. of Botany.

The first session was a presentation on **'Fishes of Nagaland: An overview'** by Ms. K Vidila Jing, Asst Prof. Dept. of Zoology.

She gave an introduction to the population of fishes at the major and minor rivers of Nagaland where many are still unexplored. She also discussed on the habitat of fishes and ichthyodiversity in north east and Nagaland. Listed some of the fishes found in Doyang and Dhansiri river and few fishes discovered in the past few years. Indigenous way of collecting fishes was also discussed in short. The presenter also briefed on the importance of studying fishes, contribution to national GDP and the threats due to anthropogenic activities. She concluded that proper documentation and scientific knowledge is important for maintaining the population of the fish diversity.

The second presenter was Ms. Hotoni Yeptho, Asst Professor Dept. of Sociology on the topic **'Nature in Naga Folklore Tradition'**. There is a close connection of nature and folklore which is expressed in the form of stories, legends, music and myth. Sacred mountains such as Yakao mountain under Noklak district, elemental spirits with reference to Momola, mythical creatures like Mushosing who changed into snake were some of the examples cited by the presenter. She also briefed on the importance of log drum and usage of artifacts.

The session concluded with a vote of thanks from Dr. Limamanen Phom, Asst Prof. Dept. of Zoology.

### **Outcome:**

The participants could gain knowledge on the recent developments in fisheries research, importance of cultivating fish and scope for promoting fish fauna from the region and state was also highlighted. Further, the participants could learn about the indispensable connection with Nature among the traditions of the Nagas as evident through Folklore studies and artifacts.
