THIS MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT IS MADE ON THIS DAY the 10th October 2019 Between the Chief Medical Officer, Tuensang, Nagaland, AND Principal, Sao Chang College, Tuensang, Nagaland.

1. GENERAL AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, Sao Chang College, Tuensang, is an Educational Institution established in 1973 and subsequently recognized as a Government College in the year 1983 under the Department of Higher Education, Government of Nagaland. The Institution (hereinafter referred to as SCC) is a premier secular College under Tuensang District providing Undergraduate Course in both Arts and Science Streams.

WHEREAS, Sao Chang College, Tuensang, headed by the Principal Dr. A. Nshoga, Vice Principal Shri. Longtichang Tzudir, Teaching Faculty and students shall be assisted by the office of the Chief Medical Officer, Tuensang, who shall provide medical aid and other basic equipments required by the patients and their particular needs.

WHEREAS, Chief Medical Office, Tuensang (hereinafter referred to as CMO) under the Directorate of Health and Family Welfare, Nagaland, Kohima, is the Supervisory head of Healthcare service in Tuensang District catering to public health issues and fulfilling the needs of the general public by providing quality health care and strengthening health services.

2. AGREEMENT

This agreement is to establish the terms and conditions under which the two parties shall mutually agree to collaborate in providing medical care to the College and render service depending on the availability of resources:

- a. The CMO shall provide basic amenities in the Medical Inspection (M.I) room in the college.
- b. From time to time medical check-ups for all the staff and students shall be provided by the office of the CMO.
- Medical/Health awareness programmes and Medical camps shall be organized in the college.
- d. Deployment of medical staff and Ambulance service during medical emergency.
- e. Both the parties shall mutually extend each other services as and when need arises.

3. DURATION.

This MoU is at-will and may be modified by mutual consent of authorized officials from Sao Chang College, Tuensang, and Chief Medical Office, Tuensang. This MoU shall become effective upon signature by the authorized officials from both the parties and will remain in effect until modified or terminated by any one of the partners by mutual consent. This agreement shall be in force for a period of 6 years from the effective date and may be renewed from time to time with mutual consent. In the absence of further mutual agreement by authorized officials from both parties, this MoU shall thenceforth be terminated.

4. SIGNATURES.
