Overview:

underscored the programme's success in fostering a meaningful connection between the two institutions.

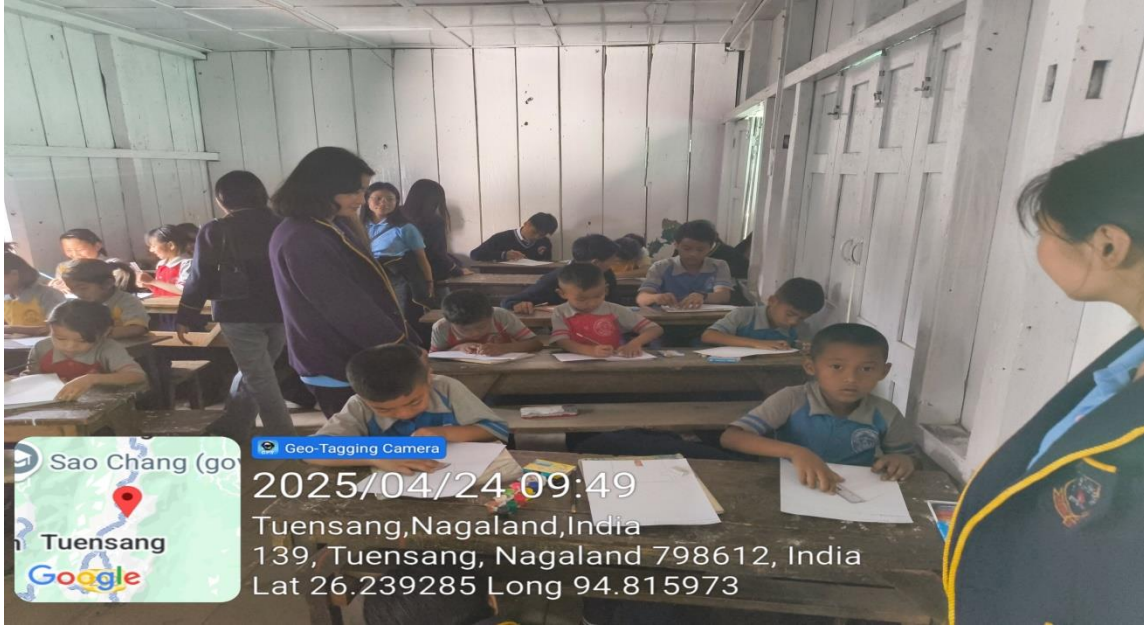

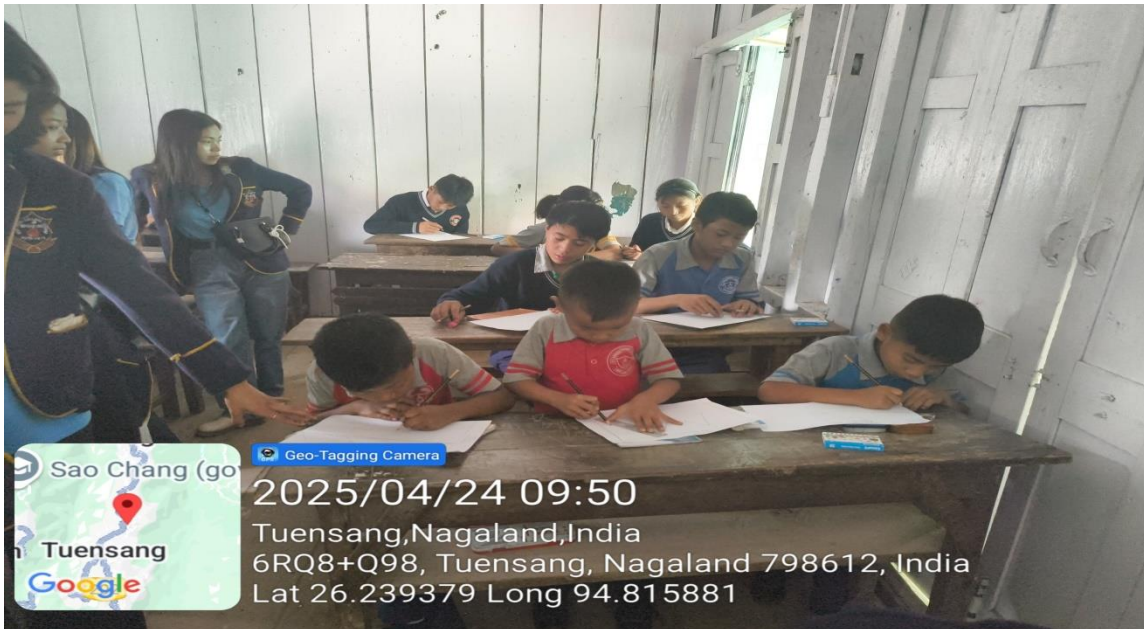
