Report on Two Day

Online Workshop on Competitive Examination Preparation

organized by Department of Political Science,

Sao Chang College, Tuensang

As per the proposal of the department faculty and with due permission form the college authority the department of Political Science, Sao Chang College Tuensang, organized a Two-Day Online workshop on Competitive Exam Preparation on 10th and 11th June, 2021. This was undertaken as a step towards providing opportunities for the students to learn beyond the prescribed syllabi.

Altogether 100 participants registered for the workshop. The schedule had 1 inaugural-cummotivation session, 4 technical sessions followed by valediction. It was fully sponsored and organized by the department.

Ms Kathyinla Jamir EAC Noklak, the motivational speaker emphasized on the need to start early, to be consistent and to care for physical as well as mental well-being.

In the technical sessions, the resource person Mr Nabum Tombou taught the participants on how to attempt questions on mental aptitude. Topics on percentage; HCF and LCM; time, speed and distance; series; profit and loss; coding and decoding; area, triangle, circles and statistics were taught. Basing on the topics covered during the session, assignments were also given for the participants to attempt on their own. The assignments were evaluated and solved the next day.

Dr A. Ethel Kikon gave guidance on reading comprehension, preparing essay and precis. Previous years' competitive exam question papers were solved in the technical sessions. The participants were also given guideline on how to find resources and on time management.




