TUENSANG, JULY 3 (MEXN): The Department of Physics, Sao Chang College Tuensang organized a national webinar on the topic 'Learn to discover and succeed through Physics at the graduation level' on June 30.

Assam-Nagaland AKM submits n

MOKOKCHUNG, JULY 3 (MEXN): Following the Assam-Nagaland border dispute which resurfaced in Tzurangkong under Mokokchung district, the Ao Students' Conference (AKM) on July 3, submitted a memorandum to the State Chief Minister, for his attention and immediate action on various points.

It stated that the Assam-Nagaland border disputes that occur from time to time has been in existence since the attainment of statehood which has hampered day to day life of many Nagas living in the border belt. Time and again, the cordial relationship between Assam and Nagaland could not be maintained over the years despite several undertakings and agreements signed between

the two States, it added.

Drawing the CM's attention to the recent incident at Tzurang valley, Mokokchung, the AKM said, "Such highhandedness of Assam Police personnel remains an unexplained mystery which is best known to the concerned."

The Aosenden Valley Nagajangka Link Road in Tzurang valley has been closed since November 2020, it highlighted.

Due to the mentioned reasons, economic linkages, bandhs, agitation is inevitable, affecting commuters and leaving citizens of Mokokchung district in jeopardy, it added.

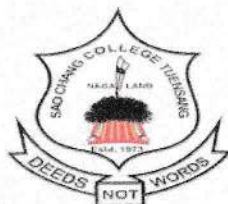
WOKHA, JULY 3 (MEXN): Youth and Student bodies in Wokha have decided to completely shut down network towers and offices of all the telecom and network service providers within the district from July 4 to 5.

The move has been taken in response to the "insincerity, lackadaisical and failure to deliver the commitments made by the

telecom/network service providers of Wokha. Lotha Youth Hoho and Lotha Students' Union (LSU) stated in a joint release on Saturday.

As per the release, a joint meeting on July 3, the LYH and LSU decided to completely shut down network towers and offices of all the telecom/network service providers in Wokha district for a minimum of two days i.e., 4 and 5, "after which appropriate measures will be initiated in the absence
