REPORT ON INTERDEPARTMENTAL SEMINAR

Organized by: **RESEARCH COMMITTEE**, Sao Chang College

The Research Committee conducted its 6th Interdepartmental Seminar on 16th February 2024. Held in College Conference Hall, the seminar was chaired by Ms. Toninaro Chongpho, Assistant Professor in Sociology.

Title of the program: Listen Learn and Grow Together **Date:** 16th February 2024.

Objective:

To present, learn and discuss on varied specialization, recent trends and developments, research papers, promote research oriented academic interest among the faculties.

Description:

In the Session 1, Ms. Rangbengkumla Chang, Assistant Professor, Department of Environmental Sciences spoke on “Assessing the impact of urban waste disposal on local water body”.

She highlighted the dumping of waste procedure in Tuensang town and explained that the open dumping is a major concern as it can lead to contamination of water bodies.

The area of her study was K. T. Colony, Second Nullah, Tuensang, with data collected from PHED Tuensang.

She raised the concern that the close proximity of dumping site and the fishery pond and cultivation field can pose hazards on human. She emphasized the need for proper waste management practice such as segregation of waste at source in order to reduce the amount of chemical leaching on the environment.

She also highlighted the non-availability of provisions for disposing E-waste in Nagaland.

The first session was followed by an interactive session.

In the second session Mr. Lemkhaba, Assistant Professor Department of Education delivered the presentation on “Status and Problems of Secondary Education in Sangtam’s Longkhim Area in Tuensang District”.

Mr. Lemkhaba, says that the education remains to be poor in Sangtam region of Longkhim area and highlights various challenges faced by the government schools in the region.

He brought forth three objectives in his study:

1. To bring out the status of secondary education in Longkhim area.
2. To identify the problems faced by the schools in Longkhim area
3. To study the reason for the cause of failure among secondary students in Longkhim area.

His research finds that students do not perform well due to lack of infrastructure, no co-curricular activities, less motivation, location of school in far-flung area which leads to isolation, lack of teaching aids, students inability to converse in English, lack of proper

technology and electricity, non completion of syllabus on time and lack of concern from the parents side. Irregularity on the part of teachers and proxy also remains major cause of failure, he said.

He also stressed the need to educate the elementary level in mother tongue.

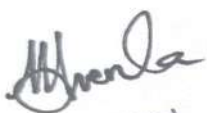
It was followed by interactive session.

Outcome:

The participants could gain knowledge on the necessity to promote environmentally friendly waste disposal based on proper scientific methods. Unguarded and unscientific means of waste disposal will damage the nearby water drainage system in the low stream area, in which human cultivation and other means are directly dependent. Thus it is important to develop scientific based area specific waste disposal methods.

In the presentation, the participants could learn the importance of ensuring basic minimum requirements in secondary learning institutions. Inadequate infrastructure and facilities for the students and administrative management is one of the main factor responsible for poor performance in the government schools. Addressing these pertinent issues will promote better performance and healthy academic competition in the state.
