REPORT COMMUNITY EXTENSION SERVICE REPORT

On May 4, 2024, Sao Chang College warmly welcomed 34 eager students and 4 accompanying staff members from GMS Chendang, Tuensang for a day filled with immersive educational activities as part of their Community Extension Service. In the freshwater aquarium section, they observed diverse aquatic life forms, learning about their habitats and behaviours. Moving on to the flora and fauna samples, students examined a variety of preserved specimens, deepening their understanding of biodiversity. Practical lessons in basic computer setup and troubleshooting followed, equipping them with essential IT skills. Demonstrations on the magnetic effect of electric currents and light dispersion through prisms captivated their scientific curiosity further.

The educational tour continued with visits to the Tribal Museum, where students gained insights into the cultural heritage and traditions of local indigenous communities. At the college library, they explored an extensive collection of books, journals, and digital resources, discovering new avenues for academic research. In the Computer Laboratory, students engaged with cutting-edge technology, witnessing ongoing projects and gaining insights into the application of computer science in various fields.

A highlight of the day was the hands-on experience in floriculture, part of the RUSA vocational course offered by the college. Students actively participated in planting and nurturing flowering plants, guided by instructors in sustainable gardening practices and modern techniques in floriculture. As a memorable takeaway, the visiting students received vegetable saplings cultivated by the 6th Floriculture Batch through innovative recycling methods, encouraging them to embrace environmental sustainability.


