- 6. The responses were collected by IQAC.
- 7. The responses were analysed by feedback committee under the supervision of IQAC.
- 8. Suggestion and recommendations were noted and sent to head of the institution for further necessary action.


Feedback by student


students responded. Maximum students responded with positive note for curriculum/ course. The unsatisfactory responses were noted by the feedback committee.

Students' Feedback 2023 -2024






Relevance of course content in enhancing analytical ability of the students ${\tt 356\,responses}$



Punctuality of teachers and completion of course on time 356 responses




The course content and workload are manageable 356 responses




Sufficient and relevant reading materials in the library






Fair and unbiased evaluation process 356 responses








Quality of academics of the college






Handling of students grievances




Relevance of the degree course/ curriculum in your career






Contribution of Alumni for progress of the college 40 responses




Encouragement of students for participation in various co curricular &extra curricular activities 40 responses




Hospitality of the institution after passing out $^{40\,\mathrm{responses}}$




FEEDBACK BY THE EMPLOYERS




How do you rate the proficiency of our student working with you 13 responses



How do you rate the relevance of course in the programme curriculum 13 responses




How do you rate the subject knowledge of our student(s) working with you in relation to programme curriculum




Rate the communication skill/research aptitude of our student working with you












Curriculum gives scope for holistic development 13 responses



Teacher's feedback






Sufficient infrastructural facilities and teaching aid 34 responses








Number of prescribed & reference books available in the library




Course curriculum is manageable


